## Topic

Our second topic of the year is called 'Does light always create a shadow?'. In this topic we will learn about light, how it is formed, how it travels and what happens when it meets transparent, translucent and opaque objects.

In Science, we will learn about how light travels and how shadows are formed.

PE is focused on fitness and hockey, helping the children to undertsand the importance of keeping healthy and how we can do this is everyday routines.

In RE, we will be learning about Christianity, who Jesus is, why he is important to Christians and how Christians welcome babies into their faith.

In Music, we will be learning to sing songs from memory, name the artist as well as begin to understand the lyrics and what the artist is trying to express through these.

In Computing, we will be learning what the Internet is and how to use a search engine. We will also be learning how to search efficiently to narrow down the information we are given.

In DT, we will be learning about how light can create and affect shadows and how to use nets to help us create 3D shapes. We will be using all of this knowledge to help us create our very own shadow puppet theatre.

In Maths, we will be learning addition and subtraction, shape and how to multiply and divide.

In English, we are reading 'The King Who Banned the Dark' in which we will learn how to write an informal letter. As always, we will have a BIG focus on presentation!
