This week our spellings are words ending in 'ent', '-ence' and '-ency'

Rule – Words ending in '-ence or -ency' are abstract nouns (a feeling, action or idea that you cannot touch) and '-ent' are adjectives (describing a noun).

'ent', 'ence' and 'ency' are normally used when the preceding letter is either a soft c (decent), soft g (regent) or qu (frequent).
