Topic

Our next topic of the year is called 'What patterns can we find around us?'. In this topic we will learn about the artist Yayoi Kasuma and how she used polka dots to create interesting and repeating patterns.

In Science, we will learn all about plants and the functions of the parts of a flower, what plants need to grow and survive and how water is transported around the plant.

PE is focused on dance, where the children will be learning the importance of unison and formation and how to use these to create interesting dances.

In RE, we are looking at how Muslims worship and why Allah is so important.

In Music, we are learning all about Caribbean and African folk music and understanding the history behind it and recognise the elements of this style of music.

In Computing, we are learning all about information can be organised and classified using branching databases.

In French, we will be learning how to speak about ourselves in our 'All about me' unit. We will be finding out how to greet each other in French alongside the numbers 1-10.

In Maths, we are continuing with learning how to multiply and divide before moving onto length and perimeter.

In English, we are reading 'The Tales of Wisdom and Wonder' with a focus on 'Monkey and Papa God' and 'The Peddler of Swaffham'.
