# **Welcome to Spring 2!**

During the next four weeks, we will be exploring our topic of 'How can we navigate our world? We will be enhancing our geographical understanding by familiarising ourselves with grid references and symbols, which are essential for accurately representing the various features of an area, as well as looking at the different types of map and their uses.

#### PE

#### Maths

In maths, we will be looking ratio and algebra, as well as building on our previous knowledge in preparation for SATs week. This will involve plenty of arithmetic and reasoning practice to fully prepare the children.

#### **English**

In English, we will be looking at the poetry collection "On the Move" by Michael Rosen. We will be discussing themes such as migration and how some people are forced to leave their home country due to fears for their safety. Our writing will consist of a formal letter to the Prime Minister, outlining the importance of helping to protect refugees from harm. Be sure to ask your child what they have been learning about to help with their retrieval!
