Sports Premium Funding: Robert Bakewell Primary School

Each year the school receives funding from the government to promote and develop sports and a healthy lifestyle at school.

This year we received double the amount we did for previous years due to government changes to approximately £18,450 and this is how we spent our money:

- Employed Mr Willbond for 5 days a week as a sports LSA to provide Big Moves (Yr1), team teach during PE lessons providing high quality PE, focused active sessions with reception (outdoor learning), high quality lunchtime sports activities, after school clubs and competition support..
- Employed Mr Willbond as a Sports midday supervisor to deliver sports activities to ensure that children are active at lunchtimes wherever possible.
- Employed 1 ME sports coach at lunch time to increase focused activity on a Monday which then quickly increased to a Friday as well. They then provided a free afternoon of team teaching with 2 classes per afternoon before providing an after school club.
- A variety of after school clubs with ME sports coaches.
- Membership to Team Charnwood which includes CPD for staff, entry to competitions and tournaments.
- Transport and subs for competitions and events if necessary (larger groups for festivals and School Games).
- Built an all-weather running track at the end of 2018 to begin using in September 2018.
- Provide an additional swimming group each year to the curriculum as a booster.
- Employ a swimming coach for the extra group during the swimming booster to work alongside the swimming leaders from school.
- Transport for the swimming booster group and hire of the swimming pool.

This year we hope to receive a similar amount to last year due to government continuing to increase activity in school and combat obesity. Approximately $\underline{\textbf{£18,450}}$ and this is how we are planning to spend our money:

- To employ and work closely with an expert in sport from Outwoods Edge to prepare children for upcoming competitions.
- To employ 1 ME sports coach every lunchtime to promote active lunchtimes. They will then cover PPA time each afternoon with 2 classes at a reduced cost or free providing high quality PE lessons. They will then provide a different afterschool club each day.
- A variety of after school clubs with ME sports coaches.
- Transport and Affiliation for competitions, events and town sports
- Purchase new schemes of work in line with the new curriculum for Gym and Dance.
- Purchase fitness gym equipment for the playground to promote fitness.
- Purchase more trim trail equipment to promote fitness
- Membership to Team Charnwood including admin, competitions, CPD, medals, certificates and festivals.

- Membership to LPAP group which includes admin, website, competitions, venue hire.
- Purchase food for food and fitness club to combat obesity and to change views on food.
- To provide booster swimming sessions to support children who struggle to swim 25m.
