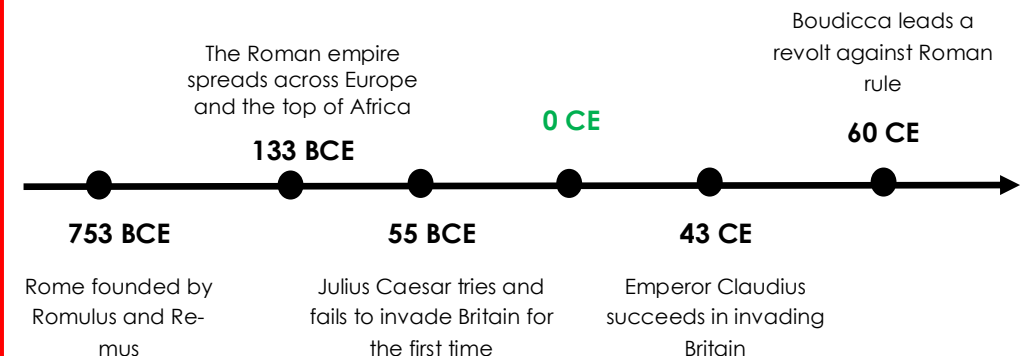
## Forces
