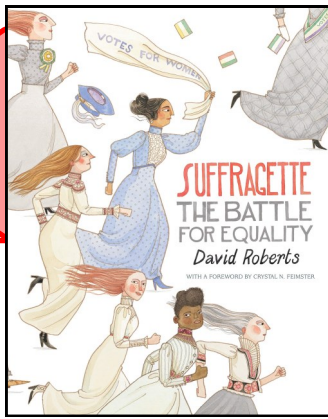


Would you have survived the Battle of Britain?



World War 2 - A Timeline of Events

Leaders

8th May 1945

German forces surrender, marking **the end of the war in Europe.**



Neville Chamberlain

The British Prime Minister at the start of the war.



Adolf Hitler

The Chancellor of Germany and leader of the Nazi Party.



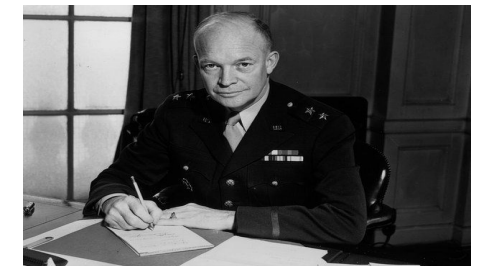
Winston Churchill

During the war, takes over from Chamberlain as the Prime Minister of Britain.



Dwight D. Eisenhower

The President of USA during World War 2.



Benito Mussolini

The Prime Minister of Italy during World War 2.

The Blitz: intense bombing undertaken by Nazi Germany against Britain.



September 1940

Anderson Shelters: built to protect people from the air raids.

Mock-up: a model or replica of a structure used for experimental purposes.



Japanese forces surrender, marking **the end of WW2.**

2nd September 1945

Democracy: a system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state, typically through elected representatives.

Autocracy: a system of government by one person with absolute power.
