Democracy: a system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state, typically through elected representatives.

Autocracy: a system of government by one person with absolute power.

The Blitz: intense bombing undertaken by Nazi Germany against Britain.



Anderson Shelters: built September 1940 to protect people from the air raids.
