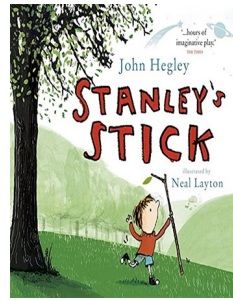
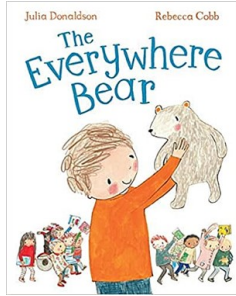


How have toys changed over time?

20th Century

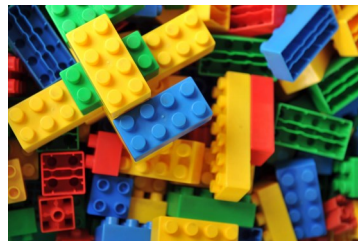
Toys: teddy bears, Barbie dolls, Action Man
