



## Would you have survived the Battle of Britain?






Australopithecus—Lived between about 3.8 and 3 million years ago in eastern Africa

Homo Erectus—The earliest




Homo Neanderthalensis— Lived from over 400,000 to about 40,000 years ago in western Eurasia.
