



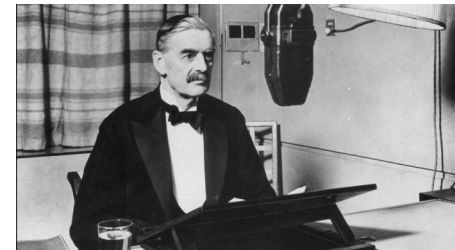
# Would you have survived the Battle of Britain?

## World War 2 - A Timeline of Events

**September 1939**

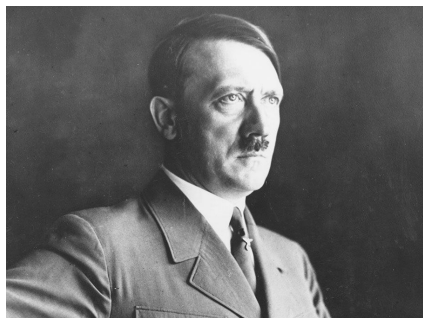
**1st September 1939**

Britain and France declare war against Germany after Hitler and his forces invade Poland.



The British Prime Minister announcing the war.

**Adolf Hitler**



The Chancellor of Germany and leader of the Nazi Party.

Children began **evacuating** from major cities to avoid the conflict.



**May 1940**

**Winston Churchill**



Becomes the Prime Minister of Britain.

**July - October 1940**



The **Battle of Britain** commences, leading to Air Force victory for Britain.

**8th May 1945**

German forces surrender, marking the **end of the war in Europe.**



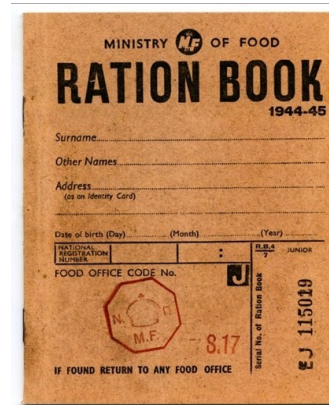
**Neville Chamberlain**

Children carry their **gas masks** in boxes and take them to the countryside.



The **rationing** of food and other resources begins in Britain.

**January 1940**



Every member of the public had a **Ration Book.**

**The Blitz** - intense bombing undertaken by Nazi Germany against Britain.



Japanese forces surrender, marking the **end of WW2.**

**September 1940**



**Anderson Shelters:** Built to protect people from the air raids.
