Birds They lay eggs. They have a beak, 2 legs, feathers and wings.

Fish They lay eggs and live and breathe under water. They have scales, fins to help them

Mammals Young grow inside their mothers and feed on their mother's milk when born. They breathe air and grow hair or fur.

Reptiles They lay eggs and have scales on their skin and breathe in air. They are cold blooded.

Carnivore Mostly eat other animals (meat)

Herbivore Eat plants and seeds only.

Omnivore Eat both plants and other animals.
