Vocabulary

Roots	Take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground.
Stem	Holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients to the leaves and flowers.
Leaves	Catch sunlight to help the plant make its own food.
Flower	Attract insects and birds.
Fruit	Contains the plant's seeds.
Deciduous	Trees lose their leaves in the Autumn.
Evergreen	Trees keep their green leaves all year round.

Parts of a plant
