


Simple	Do you have an uncomplicated idea at the heart of your project?

Entrepreneur	A person who sets up a business, taking a financial risk in the hope of a profit.	Project	An enterprise that is carefully planned to achieve a particular aim.	

Components of a Circuit and their Symbols



These symbols can be used to create electrical circuit diagrams.

circuit	A path that an electrical current can flow around.	
symbol	A visual picture that stands for something else.	
cell/battery	A device that stores chemical energy until it is needed. A cell is a single unit. A battery is a collection of cells.	
current	The flow of electrons, measured in amps.	
amps	How electric current is measured.	
voltage	The force that makes the electric current move through the wires. The greater the voltage, the more current will flow.	
resistance	The difficulty that the electric current has when flowing around a circuit.	
electrons	Very small particles that travel around an electrical circuit.
