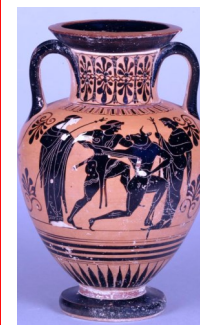
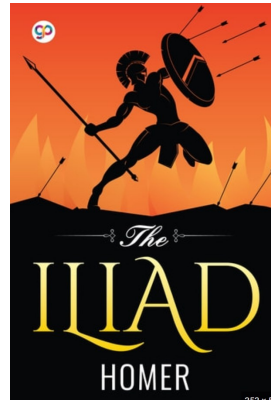


What do we have in common with the Ancient Greeks?

Ancient Greeks were also known for their architecture and clever building style. This is the Parthenon. It is 2,500 years old. The columns hold up the roof by sharing the heavy load.

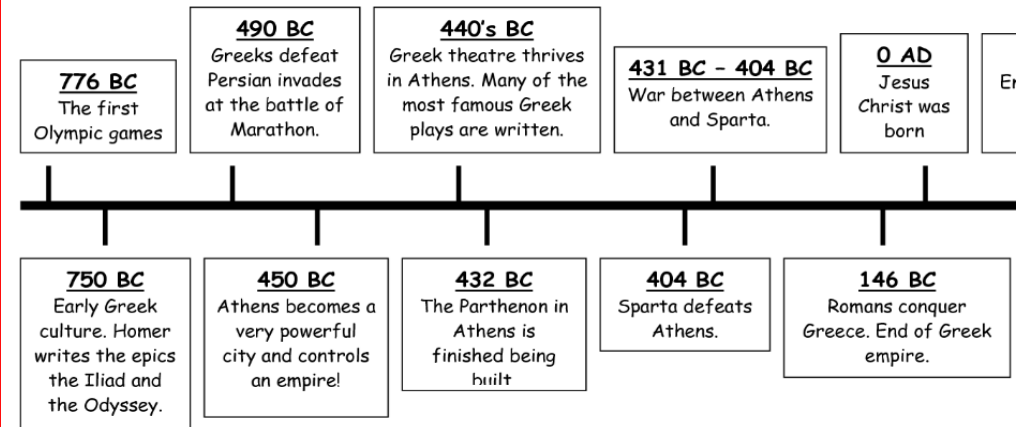
Key Vocabulary and definition

artefact	An object made by humans, often of historical interest.
Myth	A traditional story, often about the early history of a people or explaining a natural or social phenomenon, often involving <u>supernatural beings</u> or events
Olympia	A sacred site in Greece where the Olympic Games were held.
Sea/ocean	seas are smaller than oceans and are usually located where the land and ocean meet.
Reinforce	To strengthen or support with additional material.
malleable	Able to be shaped without breaking



Ancient Greeks wore clothes that were made from folded linen sheets pinned together and draped.

The tunic is called a **chiton** and the cloak is called a **himation**.
