
What do we have in common with the Ancient Greeks?

This pot shows the story of Theseus and the Minotaur.

Ancient Greeks were also known for their architecture and clever building style. This is the Parthenon. It is 2,500 years old. The columns hold up the roof by sharing the heavy load.



Ancient Greeks wore clothes that were made from folded linen sheets pinned together and draped.

The tunic is called a **chiton** and the cloak is called a **himation**.
